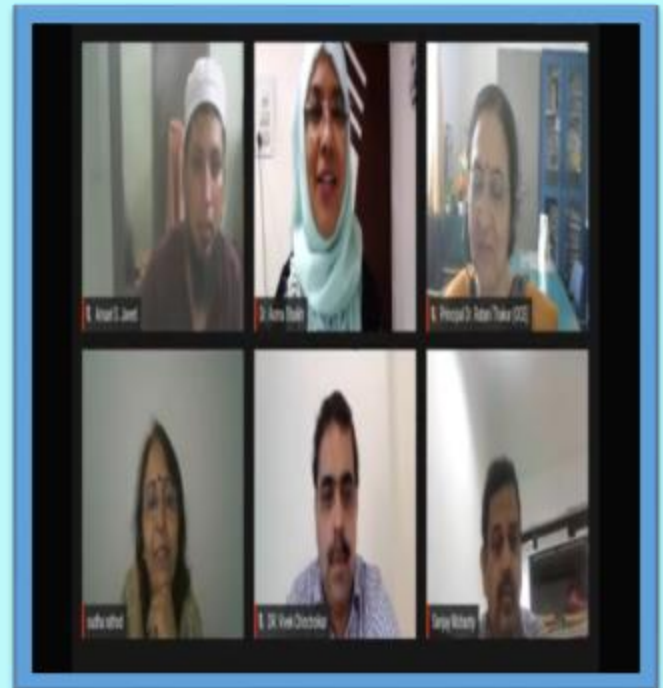

Summary

- | Women lives longer than men but disease burden is higher among women than men and women are more morbid than men
- | Childhood mortality is higher among girls than boys in each state of India
- | Under-nutrition is higher among girls than boys
- | Maternal Mortality though declining remained high in many states of India
- | Health care utilisation is lower among females than among male
- | Per-capita health spending is lower among female than male

Conclusion

- Strong and positive association of women's health and human development
- Women's health has long been neglected at household and national level
- Investment in improving women's health has largest dividend for household and country
